Benefits can't be totally separate, so within the month the T1040 code should not be used for those enrolled in both programs to eliminate partial payments in duplicate services. Discussion is ongoing, feedback is appreciated. PCE will be notified by the State of changes, but regions will work directly with their vendors to customize.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
