ASSESSMENT, SCREENING, REFERRAL TO TX

- Intake assessment; Included screening tools:

- AUDIT/C

- DAST 10

- UNCOPE

- ASAM

- CRAFFT

Other assessments:

- ASAM Continuum

- GAIN

Referral to service

- co-occurring vs primary SUD

- pre-plan requirement

- first service notes – recovery coach

ASAM CONTINUUM

- Process of determining Level of Care
- Level .5mg - Prime For Life
- Level 1 (OTP) - MAT
- Level 1 - SUD/Co-Occurring Outpatient, SUD Case Management, Recovery Coach
(Co-Occurring Capable/Enhanced)
- Level 2.1 - IOP
- Level 2.5-4 - PIHP to refer appropriate level of care.

IOP

- Matrix Model
- 8-12 weeks
- 6 groups per week – 1.5 hrs. per group
 - Early Skills, Relapse Prevention, Family Education, Seeking Safety*
 - Social Support Group – Recovery Coach*
 - SUD/Co-Occurring Outpatient Therapy weekly*

MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT

- Inclusion/exclusion Criteria
 - Inclusion Criteria: Patient is at least 18 years old, Patient meets DSM-5 criteria for Opioid Use Disorder, Patient currently receiving substance abuse or co-occurring services at Pivotal
 - Exclusion Criteria: Patient has serious uncontrolled/untreated psychiatric problems,
- Referral Process
 - Must have ASAM Continuum.
- Evaluation
 - *UDS*
 - *COWS*
 - *MAT evaluation appointment*
- Treatment
 - Induction
 - Appointment Frequency
 - Ongoing therapy

CCBHC CONSIDERATIONS

- ASAM continuum and GAIN (CCBHC handbook 12.D.4.1.3.-12.D.4.1.4.)
- Medical Detoxification Requirements (12.D.3.2)
- Required evidence-based practices (12.D.6.2.)
 - *Integrated Dual Disorder Treatment (IDDT)*
 - *Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)*
 - *Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) embed in EHR workflows ((12.D.4.3.4.)*
